1 WHEREAS, the newly developed Regulation Freedom 2 Amendment provides another method to ensure that regulatory 3 agencies remain accountable to the citizenry of the United 4 States and encourage economic growth by reducing the costs 5 associated with rules and regulations; and

6 WHEREAS, the Regulation Freedom Amendment states, 7 "Whenever one quarter of the members of the United States 8 House or the United States Senate transmit to the President 9 their written declaration of opposition to a proposed federal 10 regulation, it shall require a majority vote of the House and 11 Senate to adopt that regulation"; and

12 WHEREAS, several state legislatures throughout the 13 United States are considering the Regulation Freedom 14 Amendment; now therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 16 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the members of this body urge 17 the United States Congress to enact a Regulation Freedom 18 Amendment to the United States Constitution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House is authorized and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to each member of the Alabama Congressional Delegation.
