3 DESIGNATING THE PEGGY CULVERHOUSE MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

5 WHEREAS, a longtime and respected resident of the
6 Ariton community in Dale County, Peggy Culverhouse had an
7 unwavering faith in God and love for her family, friends, and
8 community that was best symbolized by the inspirational way
9 she faced life's many hardships; and

10 WHEREAS, full of grace and compassion for others,
11 Peggy was a devoted wife to Robert Culverhouse, proud parent
12 of Tullie and Ciara Culverhouse, loving grandmother of Rob
13 Culverhouse, and treasured daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Paul
14 Harden of Roeton; and

15 WHEREAS, an active and devout member of the Ariton
16 Baptist Church, Peggy Culverhouse knew that by trusting in
17 God, she could face the seemingly insurmountable challenges of
18 this world with the understanding that, like the sound of the
19 train's whistle that echoes so loudly beneath the bridge that
20 will bear her name, the trials and tribulations of this world
21 shall pass; now therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
23 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in memory of Peggy
24 Culverhouse, we hereby designate the bridge on Alabama Highway
25 51, mile post 22.399 to 22.400, over the Seaboard Coastline

1 Railroad, near Ariton in Dale County, Alabama, the "Peggy
2 Culverhouse Memorial Bridge."

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate public
4 authorities are respectfully requested to install and maintain
5 signs and markers designating the bridge as the Peggy
6 Culverhouse Memorial Bridge.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this
8 resolution be presented to the family of Peggy Culverhouse, so
9 that they may know of the esteem in which we hold their loved
10 one.
