18 Culverhouse, and treasured daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Paul

20 WHEREAS, an active and devout member of the Ariton  
21 Baptist Church, Peggy Culverhouse knew that by trusting in  
22 God, she could face the seemingly insurmountable challenges of  
23 this world with the understanding that, like the sound of the  
24 train's whistle that echoes so loudly beneath the bridge that  
25 will bear her name, the trials and tribulations of this world  
26 shall pass; now therefore,

1                   BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
2 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in memory of Peggy  
3 Culverhouse, we hereby designate the bridge on Alabama Highway  
4 51, mile post 22.399 to 22.400, over the Seaboard Coastline  
5 Railroad, near Ariton in Dale County, Alabama, the "Peggy  
6 Culverhouse Memorial Bridge."

7                   BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate public  
8 authorities are respectfully requested to install and maintain  
9 signs and markers designating the bridge as the Peggy  
10 Culverhouse Memorial Bridge.

11                   BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this  
12 resolution be presented to the family of Peggy Culverhouse, so  
13 that they may know of the esteem in which we hold their loved  
14 one.
