WHEREAS, a total of 40,000 United States citizens lose their lives to Pulmonary Fibrosis, annually, yet a federally funded national awareness or education effort that would enhance understanding of the fatal disease in the public and medical communities is nonexistent; and

WHEREAS, Pulmonary Fibrosis, a relentless and progressive disease, which is marked by scarring of the lungs and ultimately inhibits a person's ability to breathe, causes the same amount of deaths as Breast Cancer; and

WHEREAS, currently, 48,000 United States citizens are diagnosed with Pulmonary Fibrosis annually, and more than 200,000 United States citizens could possibly be living with the debilitating disease; notably, cases of Pulmonary Fibrosis, which have increased more than 150 percent since 2001, are expected to continue rising; and

WHEREAS, the public's awareness of Pulmonary Fibrosis remains low despite its widespread prevalence; shockingly, the public is more aware of less prevalent diseases than Pulmonary Fibrosis; and

7	WHEREAS, a Food and Drug Administration-approved
8	treatment or cure for Pulmonary Fibrosis is not available, and
9	the median survival rate for a patient affected by Pulmonary
10	Fibrosis is 2.8 years; and
11	WHEREAS, the Pulmonary Fibrosis Research Enhancement
12	Act, the first-ever legislation for Pulmonary Fibrosis
13	research funding, would dramatically assist efforts to help
14	improve the quality of lives of those affected by Pulmonary
