WHEREAS, Mr. Darwin was a member of Central Presbyterian Church; his hobbies included hiking, traveling, history, and genealogy, and he was also an Auburn football fan; and

WHEREAS, preceding him in death were his parents, Samuel Jackson Darwin, Sr., and Margaret McCollough Darwin; brother, George William Darwin, and aunt, Octovia Saunders Darwin; and

WHEREAS, survivors include his devoted wife of 54 years, Frances Lamb Darwin; son, Barton Jackson (Amber Bentley) Darwin; daughter, Sammie Darwin (Bentley Ray) Walls; five grandsons; one great-granddaughter; and a number of other relatives; and
