4 organizations and worthy causes, he is a 21-year member of the  
5 Andalusia Kiwanis Club, serving on the Board of Directors and

8 Midget League and Little League baseball program; and

9 WHEREAS, he is active in professional organizations,  
10 serving on the Board of Directors and as Past President of the  
11 Covington County Cattlemen's Association and as Regional Vice  
12 President for the Alabama Cattlemen's Association; and

13 WHEREAS, for the past 37 years, he has been a  
14 bi-vocational pastor in the Congregational Christian Church  
15 and is the current pastor of Liberty Congregational Church in  
16 Dozier, Alabama; and

17 WHEREAS, the son of Bruce and Dessie Ree Clark, he  
18 is married to the former Wanda Cotter, who retired from the  
19 Opp City School System; they have two children, Todd Clark  
20 (Pam) and Trae Clark, and two grandchildren, Ragan and Thomas;

24 accomplishments, and he is truly deserving of special
