1 WHEREAS, the members of Alberta Baptist Church were 2 thrown into some soul searching and came out of the ordeal 3 with a new commitment to have a positive impact on Alberta; 4 although the congregation decreased in numbers, the outreach 5 is greater and with the help of insurance and donations, the 6 new church is nearly debt free; and

7 WHEREAS, the Alberta Church of God used the 8 devastation as a time to relocate to Cottondale when 9 rebuilding and changed the name to LifePointe Church of God; 10 the rebuilding time also saw membership growth of the church 11 from 60 to over 300 members; and

12 WHEREAS, both congregations, left in rubble in 2011, 13 celebrated new buildings this year with renewed vigor and more 14 missions; both churches struggled and persevered hardship to 15 emerge better for it and are to be commended for that 16 dedication and never-give-up attitude; now therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the Alberta Baptist Church 18 and the LifePointe Church of God are most highly honored and 19 commended for their drive to move forward in the face of 20 21 adversity and by a copy of this resolution to each 22 congregation, we extend heartiest congratulations on 23 overcoming this crisis and on rebuilding along with best wishes for the future. 24
