8 TO BE ENTITLED
9 AN ACT

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11 To amend Sections 38-4-2, 38-4-4 and 38-11A-2 Code
12 of Alabama 1975, relating to public assistance and the
13 eligibility for means-tested public benefits to include the
14 income of a cohabiting partner when determining eligibility
15 for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF); to require
16 that an applicant for TANF apply for at least three positions
17 of unsubsidized employment prior to applying for TANF cash
18 assistance from the Department of Human Resources; and to
19 provide that TANF recipients who voluntarily terminate
20 employment shall be ineligible for receiving TANF cash
21 assistance.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. Sections 38-4-2, 38-4-4, and 38-11A-2
24 Code of Alabama 1975, are hereby amended to read as follows:

25 "§38-4-2.

26 "(a) Applications for Temporary Assistance for Needy
27 Families (TANF) cash assistance shall be made to the county

1 department in the manner prescribed by the state department
2 and shall contain such information as the state department may
3 require; provided, that nothing contained in this chapter
4 shall be construed as requiring the signing of a pauper's oath
5 on the part of any person making application for assistance
6 hereunder. An investigation and record shall be promptly made
7 by the county department of the circumstances of the
8 applicant. Upon the completion of the investigation the county
9 director shall determine whether the applicant is eligible for
10 assistance under the provisions of this chapter and the rules
11 and regulations of the state department and the amount of
12 assistance he shall receive. The county director shall give
13 notice in writing to the applicant of the action taken on his
14 application or any subsequent change in payments.

15 " (b) Within maximum matchable payments in which the
16 federal government will participate as prescribed in the
17 Federal Social Security Act, the amount of assistance to which
18 any person described in Section 38-4-1 shall be entitled
19 shall, under the rules and regulations of the state
20 department, be determined upon the basis of the amount of
21 total income and resources received by ~~such person~~ the
22 applicant, the husband or wife of the applicant and/or the
23 cohabiting partner of the applicant if such person resides in
24 the home with the applicant and has a legal obligation to
25 provide for the support of the dependent children, except as
26 provided in Section 38-4-1, and such other conditions existing
27 in each case as will determine the need for assistance for

1 such person as provided in this chapter. The amount of such
2 assistance shall be determined with due regard to the
3 conditions existing in each case, subject to the funds
4 available, and the rules and regulations and standards of the
5 state department and the provisions of this chapter.

6 "(c) No provision of this section shall affect in
7 any manner the amount paid to a widow of a Confederate veteran
8 now or hereafter placed on the pension rolls of this state.

9 "§38-4-4.

10 "If at any time the recipient of public assistance,
11 ~~or~~ the husband or wife of such recipient, and/or the
12 cohabiting partner of the recipient shall become possessed of
13 any income or resources in excess of that owned or being
14 received at the date of the application, it shall be the duty
15 of the recipient immediately to notify the county department
16 of the facts in the case. The county department, upon the
17 notification or upon otherwise learning the facts, shall,
18 after investigation, continue, reduce or cancel the amount of
19 the grant as the facts may warrant. Its action in this respect
20 shall be subject to appeal and review as provided in this
21 chapter. For the purposes of this section, where aid to
22 dependent children is the form of public assistance involved,
23 the near relative, as defined in the Federal Social Security
24 Act, shall report the acquisition of income and resources.

25 "§38-11A-2.

26 "(a) The Department of Human Resources shall
27 establish and administer a welfare employment program for

1 persons applying for, or receiving, public assistance in the
2 State of Alabama. The department shall develop program policy,
3 criteria, requirements, and procedures and issue rules and
4 regulations for governance of the program, insofar as federal
5 guidelines permit, and shall assume program management
6 responsibilities including budget planning, cost accounting,
7 data collecting and reporting, evaluation and assessment of
8 program performance, and standards for effective use of
9 distributed funds. The program shall include development of
10 employment strategies, employment-related programs and
11 activities and family support services directed toward
12 affecting the intent and goals of this chapter.

13 "(b) As a condition of eligibility for Temporary
14 Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) an applicant shall have
15 applied for at least three positions of unsubsidized
16 employment prior to completing the application process and
17 comply with job search preparation, education, and other
18 employment activities as required by the Department.

19 "(c) Recipients of TANF cash assistance who
20 voluntarily terminate employment or refuse employment without
21 good cause shall be ineligible for TANF cash assistance."

22 Section 2. Notwithstanding the provisions in Section
23 1, TANF cash assistance and eligibility requirements shall
24 conform with federal eligibility requirement standards as
25 provided for in Title IV, Part A, of the Social Security Act.

1 Section 3. This act shall become effective
2 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor or
3 its otherwise becoming law.
