8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, termination dates are  
9 established for enumerated state agencies. The  
10 agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama  
11 Sunset Committee. After the review process is  
12 completed, the committee prepares its  
13 recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature  
14 in the form of sunset bills which either continue,  
15 terminate, or continue with modification each  
16 agency reviewed.

17 This bill would provide for the continuance  
18 of the State Radiation Control Agency, with the  
19 following changes: To remove the agency from review  
20 by the Alabama Sunset Committee and to repeal the  
21 law establishing the Radiation Advisory Board of  
22 Health.

25 TO BE ENTITLED

1           Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the  
2 existence and functioning of the State Radiation Control  
3 Agency with certain modifications; to remove the agency from  
4 review by the Alabama Sunset Committee and to repeal Section  
5 22-14-5, Code of Alabama 1975, which establishes the Radiation  
6 Advisory Board of Health.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8           Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the  
9 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the State  
10 Radiation Control Agency, with the additional recommendation  
11 for statutory change as set out in Section 3.

12           Section 2. The existence and functioning of the  
13 State Radiation Control Agency, created and functioning  
14 pursuant to Sections 22-14-1 to 22-14-4, inclusive, 22-14-6 to  
15 22-14-35, inclusive, and 22-32-4 to 22-32-8, inclusive, Code  
16 of Alabama 1975, is continued, and those code sections are  
17 expressly preserved.

18           Section 3. Commencing on the effective date of this  
19 act, the State Radiation Control Agency is no longer an  
20 enumerated agency subject to review by the Alabama Sunset  
21 Committee.

22           Section 4. Section 22-14-5, Code of Alabama 1975,  
23 establishing the Radiation Advisory Board of Health, is  
24 repealed.

25           Section 5. The Legislature concurs in the  
26 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in  
27 Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4.

1                   Section 6. This act shall become effective  
2           immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or  
3           its otherwise becoming law.
