8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, a quorum of the members
9 of the Board of Trustees of the Alabama School of
10 Fine Arts is necessary for the transaction of
11 business.

12 This bill would authorize the board to
13 select an executive committee that may transact
14 business of the board in lieu of a quorum of the
15 board.

21 To amend Section 16-26B-6, Code of Alabama 1975,
22 relating to the Board of Trustees of the Alabama School of
23 Fine Arts; to authorize the board to select an executive
24 committee to transact business of the board in lieu of a
25 quorum of the board.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. Section 16-26B-6 of the Code of Alabama
2 1975, is amended to read as follows:

3 "§16-26B-6.

4 "(a) A majority of actively serving members of the
5 school board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of
6 business. All official actions of the board shall require the
7 favorable vote of a majority of those members present and
8 voting.

9 "(b) Members of the school board shall be
10 compensated for all actual vouchered expenses incurred in the
11 performance of their duties and functions as required by this
12 chapter. The expenses shall be paid by the executive director
13 from funds appropriated by the Legislature and upon the
14 warrant of the school board.

15 "(c) The school board may select from its number an
16 executive committee of three, subject to change and removal by
17 the majority of the board at any time. The executive committee
18 may meet and transact any business that may be transacted by a
19 majority of the board, and whatever acts the executive
20 committee may do shall be considered as done by the whole
21 board."

22 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
23 first day of the third month following its passage and
24 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
