1 SB163 2 3 4 ENGROSSED 5 6 7 A BTTT TO BE ENTITLED 8 AN ACT 9 10 11 To amend Section 13A-11-270, Code of Alabama 1975; 12 to provide criminal penalties for selling, installing, or 13 reinstalling a device in a motor vehicle that causes the 14 vehicle's diagnostic system to inaccurately indicate that the 15 vehicle is equipped with a functional airbag; to provide criminal penalties for installing or requesting another to 16 17 install a counterfeit airbag or nonfunctional airbag and selling or offering to sell the vehicle to another with the 18 intent to deceive the purchaser about the existence of the 19 counterfeit airbag or nonfunctional airbag in the vehicle; to 20 21 provide enhanced criminal penalties for committing airbag 22 fraud that causes physical injury; to repeal Section 13A-11-271, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the fraudulent 23 24 sale of a motor vehicle without an airbag; and in connection 25 therewith would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the 26

meaning of Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
5	Section 1. Section 13A-11-270, Code of Alabama 1975,
6	is amended to read as follows:
7	"§13A-11-270.
8	"(a) For the purposes of this section, the following
9	terms shall have the following meanings:
10	"(1) AIRBAG. A motor vehicle inflatable occupant
11	restraint system or any component thereof that satisfies both
12	of the following:
13	"a. Operates in the event of a crash.
14	"b. Was designed in accordance with all applicable
15	federal safety standards for the specific make, model, and
16	year of the motor vehicle in which it is or will be installed.
17	"(2) COUNTERFEIT AIRBAG. A replacement motor vehicle
18	inflatable occupant restraint system or any component thereof
19	displaying a mark identical or similar to the genuine mark of
20	a motor vehicle manufacturer without authorization from the
21	manufacturer.
22	"(3) NONFUNCTIONAL AIRBAG. A replacement motor
23	vehicle inflatable occupant restraint system or any component
24	thereof that satisfies any of the following:
25	"a. Was previously deployed or damaged.

1	"b. Has a fault that is detected by the vehicle
2	diagnostic system after the installation procedure is
3	completed.
4	"c. Includes any part or object, including, but not
5	limited to, a counterfeit airbag, a nonfunctional airbag, or a
6	repaired airbag cover, installed in a motor vehicle to mislead
7	the owner or operator of such motor vehicle into believing
8	that a functional airbag has been installed.
9	" (a)<u>(</u>b) A person commits the offense of fraudulent
10	repair of an airbag <u>fraud</u> if , after an airbag has been
11	deployed in a motor vehicle, the person knowingly and
12	intentionally as defined in Section 13A-2-2, does either any
13	of the following:
14	"(1) Installs <u>Manufactures, imports, sells, offers</u>
15	<u>for sale, installs, or reinstalls</u> a new <u>counterfeit airbag, a</u>
16	nonfunctional airbag, or any other device to replace an airbag
17	which that the person knew was not designed in accordance with
18	all applicable federal safety standards for the make, model,
19	and year of the motor vehicle.
20	"(2) Installs a used airbag in a motor vehicle and
21	fails to disclose to the owner or lessee that a used airbag
22	has been installed.
23	" <u>(3) Sells any device, or installs or reinstalls in</u>
24	any vehicle any device, that causes the vehicle's diagnostic
25	system to inaccurately indicate that the vehicle is equipped
26	with a functional airbag when a counterfeit airbag,
27	nonfunctional airbag, or no airbag is installed.

1 "(4) Installs or requests another to install a 2 counterfeit airbag or nonfunctional airbag and sells or offers to sell the vehicle to another person with the intent to 3 4 deceive the purchaser about the existence of the counterfeit airbag or nonfunctional airbag in the vehicle. 5 6 "(b) Fraudulent repair of an airbag (c) Airbag fraud 7 is a Class A misdemeanor. If the fraud contributes to a person's serious physical injury or death, airbag fraud is a 8 Class C felony." 9 10 Section 2. Section 13A-11-271, Code of Alabama 1975, 11 relating to the fraudulent sale of a motor vehicle without an 12 airbag, is repealed. 13 Section 3. Although this bill would have as its 14 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased 15 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621, now 16 17 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of 18 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the 19 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime. 20 Section 4. This act shall become effective on the 21

first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
