11 To make a supplemental appropriation from the
12 Enforcement Seizure Fund to the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage
13 Control Board in the amount of \$700,000 for the fiscal year
14 ending September 30, 2014; to make a supplemental
15 appropriation from the Music Hall of Fame Fund to the Alabama
16 Music Hall of Fame Board in the amount of \$80,000 for the
17 fiscal year ending September 30, 2014; to require a transfer
18 of \$50,000 from the Enforcement Seizure Fund of the Alabama
19 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to the State General Fund for
20 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014; to make a
21 supplemental appropriation of \$50,000 from the State General
22 Fund to the Court of Civil Appeals for the fiscal year ending
23 September 30, 2014; to make a supplemental appropriation of
24 \$25,300 from the Forfeited Assets Fund to the Department of
25 Forensic Sciences for the fiscal year ending September 30,
26 2014; to require a transfer of \$125,000 from the Departmental
27 Emergency Fund to the Alabama Job Creation and Military

1 Stability Commission, as established pursuant to Act 2011-350,
2 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014; to require a
3 transfer from the Departmental Emergency Fund and
4 appropriation to the Alabama Job Creation and Military
5 Stability Commission, as established pursuant to Act 2011-350,
6 in the amount of \$125,000 for the fiscal year ending September
7 30, 2014; to require a transfer of \$1,500,000 from the Office
8 of the Attorney General to the Office of Prosecution Services
9 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014; and to amend
10 appropriations made in Section 2C of Act 2013-263 for the
11 fiscal year ending September 30, 2014.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

13 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations
14 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
15 \$700,000 from the Enforcement Seizure Fund to the Alabama
16 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for the fiscal year ending
17 September 30, 2014.

18 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations
19 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
20 \$80,000 from the Music Hall of Fame Fund to the Alabama Music
21 Hall of Fame Board for the fiscal year ending September 30,
22 2014.

23 Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations
24 heretofore or hereafter made, the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage
25 Control Board shall transfer \$50,000 from the Enforcement
26 Seizure Fund to the State General Fund for the fiscal year
27 ending September 30, 2014.

1 Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations
2 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
3 \$50,000 from the State General Fund to the Court of Civil
4 Appeals for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014.

5 Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations
6 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
7 \$25,300 from the Forfeited Assets Fund to the Department of
8 Forensic Sciences for the fiscal year ending September 30,
9 2014.

10 Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations
11 heretofore or hereafter made, there shall be transferred from
12 the Departmental Emergency Fund provided for in Section
13 41-4-94, Code of Alabama 1975, and appropriated to the Alabama
14 Job Creation and Military Stability Commission, as established
15 pursuant to Act 2011-350, the amount of \$125,000 for the
16 fiscal year ending September 30, 2014.

17 Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations
18 heretofore or hereafter made, the Office of the Attorney
19 General shall transfer \$1,500,000 to the Office of Prosecution
20 Services from the funds received pursuant to the National
21 Mortgage Settlement for the fiscal year ending September 30,
22 2014.

23 Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations
24 heretofore or hereafter made, \$1,500,000 of the appropriation
25 made within the Court Operations Program of the Office of
26 Prosecution Services in Section 2C of Act 2013-263 shall
27 consist of a transfer from the Office of the Attorney General

1 from funds received from the National Mortgage Settlement.
2 This appropriation shall be distributed to the District
3 Attorney's Office in each Judicial Circuit in proportion to
4 the State General Fund allocations to those offices made in
5 Act 2013-263. This appropriation must be used for costs of
6 investigation and litigation of law enforcement efforts to
7 prevent and prosecute financial fraud and/or for public
8 protection services.

9 Section 9. This act shall become effective
10 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
11 upon its otherwise becoming law.
