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8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, motor vehicle license
9 plates and validation decals are manufactured by
10 the Department of Corrections and distributed by
11 the local judge of probate or other license plate
12 issuing official.

13 This bill would authorize the Department of
14 Revenue to contract with a third party to
15 manufacture and distribute license plates and
16 validation decals under certain conditions.

19 TO BE ENTITLED
20 AN ACT

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22 To add Section 32-6-64.1 to the Code of Alabama
23 1975, relating to motor vehicles; to authorize the Department
24 of Revenue to contract with a third party to manufacture and
25 distribute license plates and validation decals; and to
26 provide for the transfer and appropriation of certain funds to
27 the Department of Corrections.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. Section 32-6-64.1 is added to the Code of
3 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

4 §32-6-64.1.

5 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
6 title, the Department of Revenue may contract with a third
7 party to manufacture and distribute license plates and
8 validation decals.

9 (b) The same amount for each license plate and
10 validation decal distributed as provided for in subsection (a)
11 shall continue to be distributed to the Department of
12 Corrections as the Department of Corrections is otherwise
13 receiving per license plate or decal for the manufacture of a
14 license plate or decal on the effective date of this section.
15 Any amounts distributed to the Department of Corrections
16 pursuant to this subsection are continuously appropriated to
17 the Department of Corrections for the operation of the
18 Department of Corrections.

19 (c) The distribution of a license plate or
20 validation decal pursuant to this section shall not affect the
21 issuance fee of the judge of probate or other license plate
22 issuance official.

23 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
24 with this act are repealed.

25 Section 3. This act shall become effective
26 immediately following its passage and approval by the
27 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
