8 TO BE ENTITLED  
9 AN ACT

11 To amend Section 40-12-30, Code of Alabama 1975,  
12 relating to the Department of Revenue rule-making power  
13 regarding licenses issued by the department; to require an  
14 applicant to submit his or her federal tax identification  
15 number or Social Security number.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. Section 40-12-30, Code of Alabama 1975,  
18 is amended to read as follows:

19 "§40-12-30.

20 "(a) The Department of Revenue is hereby authorized  
21 to promulgate reasonable rules and regulations relating to the  
22 administration and enforcement of the provisions of this act  
23 and those other provisions of this chapter relating to the  
24 licensing of automobile and other motor vehicle dealers not in  
25 conflict with the specific provisions hereof.

26 "(b) Every applicant for a new license and renewal  
27 issued pursuant to Articles 2, 6, 8, and 9 of Chapter 12 of

1 Title 40 shall provide to the issuing agent the applicant's  
2 federal employer identification number or, if the applicant is  
3 a sole proprietorship and does not possess same, the  
4 applicant's Social Security number. The federal employer  
5 identification number or Social Security number shall be  
6 included with the license information reported to the  
7 department by each county.

8 "(c) All business privilege license application  
9 information for new licenses and renewals shall be transmitted  
10 electronically to the department by the probate judge or other  
11 county licensing official in a manner as prescribed by the  
12 department."

13 Section 2. This act shall become effective on  
14 October 1, 2014, following its passage and approval by the  
15 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
