19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
20	Section 1. This act shall apply only in Jackson
21	County.
22	Section 2. (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the
23	contrary, the county commission may reimburse the Jackson
24	County General Fund for all payments made from the general
25	fund for, or related to, the operation of the Jackson County
26	Solid Waste Program. Funds used for a reimbursement by the
27	county commission shall be derived from surplus funds over the

operating costs of the Jackson County Solid Waste Program as determined by standard government fund accounting principles.

(b) The county commission may receive a reasonable administrative fee payable to the Jackson County General Fund by a transfer of funds from the Solid Waste Fund in an amount up to five percent of the gross revenue generated by the Jackson County Solid Waste Program on an annual basis in order to reimburse the county general fund for expenses related to the administration of the solid waste program and fund.

Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
