8	EXPRESSING LEGISLATIVE INTENT REGARDING THE
9	EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN VESSELS THAT MAY EMPLOY A SAIL FROM
10	REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS.
11	
12	WHEREAS, the Legislature enacted certain provisions
13	within Article 1, Chapter 5, Title 33, Code of Alabama 1975,
14	to authorize the Department of Conservation and Natural
15	Resources to require owners of certain vessels used as a means
16	of transportation on the waters of this state to obtain
17	certificates of registration and numbers for the vessels; and
18	WHEREAS, Section 33-5-17, Code of Alabama 1975,
19	authorizes an annual fee in the amount of eighteen dollars
20	(\$18), plus a two-dollar (\$2) issuance fee for vessels less
21	than 16 feet in length; and,
22	WHEREAS, Section 33-5-19, Code of Alabama 1975,
23	exempts a vessel not propelled by machinery, except sail boats
24	and boats for hire, from the numbering requirements contained
25	in Article 1, Chapter 5, Title 33, Code of Alabama 1975; and
26	WHEREAS, the term "sailboat" is commonly defined as
27	"a boat usually propelled by sail"; therefore, it is not the

intent of the Legislature to require registration of a vessel that occasionally employs a sail; and

WHEREAS, based upon the express exemption for a vessel not propelled by machinery from the numbering requirements as well as the common definition of "sailboat," it is the clear intent of the Legislature in the enactment of the registration and numbering scheme in Article 1, Chapter 5, Title 33, Code of Alabama 1975, not to require registration and numbering of a canoe or kayak or other floating device that has as a principal means of propulsion an individual with a paddle, even if a sail is employed on the vessel from time to time; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Legislature hereby affirmatively states that the intent of the Legislature in the enactment of the provisions within Article 1, Chapter 5, Title 33, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the registration of vessels used as a means of transportation on water, was to exempt from any registration requirements a canoe or kayak or other floating device that has as a principal means of propulsion an individual with a paddle, even if a sail is employed on the vessel from time to time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Commissioner of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources that the department may know of our intent.
