8 WHEREAS, on December 21, 1984, State Trooper Simmie
9 Jeffries died while on duty in a tragic accident at the
10 intersection of U.S. Highway 72 and Interstate 65 in Limestone
11 County, prompting the installation of a traffic signal shortly
12 thereafter at the intersection; and

13 WHEREAS, it is appropriate that Trooper Jeffries be
14 honored for the sacrifice he made and that the daily service
15 and sacrifice made by all law enforcement personnel should be
16 recognized; now therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
18 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That, in memory and honor of State
19 Trooper Simmie Jeffries, we hereby designate the bridge
20 crossing I65 on U.S. Highway 72 at mile marker 76.756 in
21 Limestone County as the "State Trooper Simmie Jeffries
22 Memorial Bridge."

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate
24 officials are requested to install and maintain signs
25 designating the State Trooper Simmie Jeffries Memorial Bridge.
