This act is enacted pursuant to the 7 plenary authority of the Legislature to alter or rearrange the boundaries of a city or town pursuant to subdivision (18) of 8 Section 104 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901. 9 10 Section 3. If any part of this act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the annexation in subsection (a) 11 12 of Section 1 shall be null and void. 13 Section 4. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of 14 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is 15 proposed to be annexed to the City of Lincoln is on file in the office of the Judge of Probate in Talladega County, 16

Section 5. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
