10 ~~without charge, legislators shall be furnished up to two free~~  
11 ~~printed copies of the voter lists for their districts during a~~  
12 ~~legislative quadrennium and resale of the lists shall be~~  
13 ~~strictly prohibited.~~ The Secretary of State shall provide,  
14 without charge, each legislator one copy of the voter list in  
15 his or her district within 90 days of his or her assuming  
16 office. Upon application and without charge, the  
17 Administrative Office of Courts shall be provided with an  
18 electronic copy of the statewide voter list no more than once  
19 a year for its use in the production of a master jury list or  
20 for any other lawful purpose. Resale of any portion of the  
21 list by the Administrative Office of Courts shall be strictly  
22 prohibited."

23 Section 2. This act shall become effective  
24 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
25 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
