Relating to the City of Fort Payne in DeKalb County; authorizing the sale of draft or keg beer or malt beverages by properly licensed retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board upon the adoption of an ordinance of the Fort Payne City Council.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. This act shall only apply to the City of
10 Fort Payne in DeKalb County.

11 Section 2. The sale of draft or keg beer or malt 12 beverages by retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage 13 Control Board is authorized in the City of Fort Payne. All 14 resolutions and ordinances relating to the sale, consumption, 15 and possession of bottled or canned beer in such city shall 16 apply to draft or keg beer or malt beverages. The Fort Payne 17 City Council may adopt an ordinance regulating the sale of 18 draft or keg beer or malt beverages pursuant to this act.

19 Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict 20 with this act are repealed. However, the provisions of this 21 act are cumulative and supplementary and shall not be 22 construed to repeal or supersede any laws or parts of laws not 23 directly inconsistent herewith. HB223
