10 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall
11 be punished by a fine of not less than two hundred fifty
12 dollars (\$250) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500), or
13 by imprisonment in the county jail for six months, or by both
14 a fine and imprisonment."~~

15 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
16 first day of the third month following its passage and
17 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
