26	prior to discharge, shall offer immunizations against
27	influenza virus to all inpatients age 65 and older unless the

patient would be contraindicated. The offer of an influenza immunization shall be contingent upon the availability of the vaccine.

(b) A hospital or health care provider acting in good faith and in accordance with generally accepted health care standards applicable to such hospital or health care provider shall not be subject to administrative, civil, or criminal liability or discipline for unprofessional conduct for not complying with the requirements of this section.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
