The FMCSA has certain 12 optional regulations that states are allowed to 13 adopt as a variance without jeopardizing the funding of the state from the Commercial Motor 14 15 Carrier Safety Assistance Program. 16 This bill would adopt the allowable variances for the hours of service limitations for 17 18 intrastate commercial motor vehicles. 19 20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 21 22 AN ACT 23 24 Relating to commercial motor vehicles operating in intrastate transportation; to adopt the allowable variances 25 for hours of service limitations. 26 27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The intrastate hours of service
 limitations applied to the drivers of commercial motor
 vehicles operating in intrastate transportation, except when
 prohibited by federal rule or law, shall be the following:

5 (1) A 12-hour driving limit, provided driving a
6 commercial motor vehicle after having been on duty for more
7 than 16 hours is prohibited.

8 (2) Driving shall be prohibited for any driver who
9 has been on duty 70 hours in seven consecutive days or 80
10 hours in eight consecutive days.

11 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 12 first day of the third month following its passage and 13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
