4 (c) (1) By June 1, 2016, unless otherwise
5 established, each board shall consider a code of ethics
6 resolution that provides for the development of an ethics
7 compliance form. The form shall be completed annually by then
8 current and future board members and shall include, but not be
9 limited to, the disclosure of all of the following:

10 a. Business or non-privileged professional
11 relationships with other individual board members or any
12 entity affiliated with a board member, to the extent known.

13 b. The nature of all substantial contractual,
14 employment, and personal or familial financial interests in
15 the institution.

16 c. A statement of intent to comply with respective
17 governing board standards and other core principles and
18 requirements of the accrediting agency.

19 (2) The ethics compliance form shall be signed,
20 ~~notarized, and sealed by a notary public of the State of~~
21 ~~Alabama or a notary public of the state in which the board~~
22 ~~member resides.~~ and attested to, by the board member as true
23 to the best of his/her knowledge. Said signature may be
24 electronic.

25 (d) It is the intent of the Legislature that
26 constitutionally created boards of trustees comply with the
27 requirements of this section.

1 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
2 first day of the third month following its passage and
3 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
