Section 1. Section 12-18-133 Code of Alabama 1975,
are hereby amended to read as follows:

"§12-18-133.

4 "Any justice of the Supreme Court, judge of the Court of Civil Appeals, judge of the Court of Criminal 5 Appeals, circuit judge, or district judge who has 24 years of 6 7 at least 120 months of creditable service in the Judicial Retirement Fund of Alabama may elect to purchase credit in the 8 Judicial Retirement Fund of Alabama for up to one 12 9 10 additional year months. Any justice or judge eligible to purchase such the credit shall be awarded such the credit 11 12 provided that the justice or judge shall pay into the Judicial Retirement Fund of Alabama a sum of money which is equal to 13 14 the annual monthly contribution of both the justice or judge 15 and the annual monthly contribution of the state into the fund at the time of election to purchase the credit multiplied by 16 17 each year month or fraction thereof of service credit claimed purchased up to 12 months. The election and payment shall be 18 made to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Employees' Retirement 19 System of Alabama, administrator of the Judicial Retirement 20 21 Fund. All payments due for the purchases shall be due in full 22 at least 30 days prior to the last work date before 23 retirement."

24 Section 2. The act shall become effective on the 25 first day of the third month following its passage and 26 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
