2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Shelby County; to amend Section 3 of Act
4 79-524, 1979 Regular Session, (Acts 1979, p. 935), as amended
5 by Act 94-547 of the 1994 Regular Session, (Acts 1994, p.
6 1001), establishing a personnel board for employees of county
7 law enforcement officers in the county; to provide for the
8 appointment and compensation of up to two majors in the Office
9 of the Sheriff in the unclassified service to be appointed by
10 and serve at the pleasure of the sheriff; and to provide that
11 the positions of major shall not be subject to the
12 jurisdiction of the Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel
13 Board.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

15 Section 1. Section 3 of Act 79-524 of the 1979
16 Regular Session, (Acts 1979, p. 935), as amended by Act 94-547
17 of the 1994 Regular Session, (Acts 1994, p. 1001), is amended
18 to read as follows:

19 "Section 3. This act shall apply to all law
20 enforcement employees of Shelby County but shall not apply to
21 the following persons: (a) elective officers of the county or
22 any municipality therein; (b) members of county or municipal
23 appointive boards, commissions, and committees; (c) all
24 employees of county or municipal boards of education engaged
25 in the profession of teaching or in supervising teaching in

1 the public schools; (d) the judge of any court; (e) any
2 employee of the United States government or any agency
3 thereof; (f) any employee of the State of Alabama or any
4 departments therein; (g) the chief deputy in the sheriff's
5 department; (h) the operations manager of the Shelby County
6 Sheriff's Department who shall be appointed by the sheriff in
7 the unclassified service of the county and serve at the
8 pleasure of the sheriff; and (i) up to two majors who shall be
9 appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the sheriff in the
10 unclassified service of the county and not subject to the
11 board and whose compensation shall be 10 percent greater than
12 the highest paid classified service county law enforcement
13 employee of Shelby County."

14 Section 2. This act shall become effective
15 immediately following its passage and approval by the
16 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
