13 Relating to Shelby County; to amend Section 3 of Act
14 79-524, 1979 Regular Session, (Acts 1979, p. 935), as amended
15 by Act 94-547 of the 1994 Regular Session, (Acts 1994, p.
16 1001), establishing a personnel board for employees of county
17 law enforcement officers in the county; to provide for the
18 appointment and compensation of up to two majors in the Office
19 of the Sheriff in the unclassified service to be appointed by
20 and serve at the pleasure of the sheriff; and to provide that
21 the positions of major shall not be subject to the
22 jurisdiction of the Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel
23 Board.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

25 Section 1. Section 3 of Act 79-524 of the 1979
26 Regular Session, (Acts 1979, p. 935), as amended by Act 94-547

1 of the 1994 Regular Session, (Acts 1994, p. 1001), is amended
2 to read as follows:

3 "Section 3. This act shall apply to all law
4 enforcement employees of Shelby County but shall not apply to
5 the following persons: (a) elective officers of the county or
6 any municipality therein; (b) members of county or municipal
7 appointive boards, commissions, and committees; (c) all
8 employees of county or municipal boards of education engaged
9 in the profession of teaching or in supervising teaching in
10 the public schools; (d) the judge of any court; (e) any
11 employee of the United States government or any agency
12 thereof; (f) any employee of the State of Alabama or any
13 departments therein; (g) the chief deputy in the sheriff's
14 department; (h) the operations manager of the Shelby County
15 Sheriff's Department who shall be appointed by the sheriff in
16 the unclassified service of the county and serve at the
17 pleasure of the sheriff; and (i) up to two majors who shall be
18 appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the sheriff in the
19 unclassified service of the county and not subject to the
20 board and whose compensation shall be 10 percent greater than
21 the highest paid classified service county law enforcement
22 employee of Shelby County."

23 Section 2. This act shall become effective
24 immediately following its passage and approval by the
25 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
