20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. Section 2 of Act 1225, 1969 Regular
22	Session (Acts 1969, p. 2297), as last amended by Act 2005-280,
23	is amended to read as follows:
24	"Section 2. Division Into Exempt and Classified
25	Services. All offices and positions of the city shall be
26	divided into the exempt service and the classified service.
27	The exempt service shall include: the positions of all elected

1 officials to the city; the positions of voluntary personnel 2 and personnel appointed to serve without pay; the positions of consultants rendering temporary professional service; all 3 4 positions involving seasonal or part-time employment; 5 provided, however, such positions in the exempt service held 6 by employees of boards and commissions may be placed in the 7 classified service by resolution of the governing body, after favorable recommendation by such other board or commission, 8 and the governing body in such resolution shall prescribe the 9 10 conditions under which the employees holding such positions so transferred may acquire permanent status in such positions so 11 12 long as such positions remain in the classified service. The 13 classified service shall include all positions in the city 14 service that are paid out of the general fund of the city and 15 out of funds of boards and commissions whose employees are placed in the classified service, and which are not 16 17 specifically placed in the exempt service; provided, however, the governing body may by resolution, pursuant to a 18 recommendation by the boards, remove any position from the 19 20 classified service and place it in the exempt service. Unless 21 otherwise specifically provided or clearly implied, the 22 provisions of this act shall apply only to the classified 23 service."

24 Section 2. This act shall become effective 25 immediately following its passage and approval by the 26 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
