10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Russell County; authorizing the county
14 commission to levy an additional issuance fee on motor vehicle
15 registrations; and to provide for the use of the proceeds.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. This act shall apply only to Russell
18 County.

19 Section 2. (a) The County Commission of Russell
20 County, upon the adoption of a resolution by a recorded roll
21 call vote, may levy an additional annual issuance fee of up to
22 ten dollars (\$10) on each motor vehicle registration in the
23 county. This issuance fee shall be in addition to all other
24 charges, costs, taxes, or fees levied on the issuance of all
25 annual motor vehicle registrations.

26 (b) Those persons exempt from paying ad valorem
27 taxes under Section 40-9-21, Code of Alabama 1975, are exempt

1 from the annual issuance fee authorized by this act for one
2 motor vehicle per year.

3 Section 3. The annual issuance fee shall become due
4 at the same time the state license and registration fee
5 becomes due pursuant to Section 32-6-61, Code of Alabama 1975,
6 provided the fee shall not be collected more than once in a
7 12-month period per motor vehicle.

8 Section 4. (a) The county commission may adopt and
9 promulgate rules necessary for the collection and enforcement
10 of the issuance fee authorized by this act and may expend
11 proceeds from the fees as may be necessary to collect and
12 enforce the issuance fee.

13 (b) The remaining proceeds shall be distributed as
14 followings:

15 (1) Forty percent of the proceeds from the fee
16 authorized by this act shall be deposited into the general
17 fund of the City of Phenix City to be used for the building,
18 repair, and maintenance of roads, bridges, and sidewalks
19 located within the corporate limits of Phenix City.

20 (2) Sixty percent of the proceeds from the fee
21 authorized by this act shall be deposited into the county
22 general fund to be expended at the discretion of the county
23 commission. Of this amount, the county commission may deposit
24 a percentage of the proceeds deposited in the county general
25 fund in the general fund of the City of Hurtsboro to be used
26 for the building, repair, and maintenance of roads, bridges,

1 and sidewalks located within the corporate limits of the City
2 of Hurtsboro.

3 Section 5. This act shall become effective January
4 1, 2016, upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
5 upon its otherwise becoming a law.
