18 To add Section 6-10-6.1 to the Code of Alabama 1975,
19 to specify that wages, salaries, or other compensation of a
20 resident are not personal property for the purposes of
21 exemption from garnishment, levy, sale under execution, or
22 other process for the collection of debt.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. Section 6-10-6.1 is added to the Code of
25 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

26 §6-10-6.1.

1 (a) Wages, salaries, or other compensation of a
2 resident are not personal property for the purposes of
3 exemption from garnishment, levy, sale under execution, or
4 other process for the collection of debt.

5 (b) It is the intent of this section to exclude from
6 the meaning of personal property the wages, salaries, or other
7 compensation of a resident for the purposes of the personal
8 property exemption under Section 6-10-6 and Section 204 of the
9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901.

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective
11 immediately following its passage and approval by the
12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
