ENROLLED, An Act,

To amend Section 12-19-92 of the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the fees of constables for the service of civil process, to increase the fees for service of process by constables in Jefferson County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 12-19-92 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§12-19-92.

"(a) Constables shall be entitled to the following fees for the following services in civil cases in which the amount in controversy is less than \$20.00:

- (1) Serving summons \$.50
- (2) Summoning each witness .25
- (3) Levying an attachment for not more than \$50.00 .75
- (4) Levying an attachment for more than \$50.00 1.00
- (5) Levying an execution for not more than \$50.00 .50
- (6) Levying an execution for more than \$50.00 1.00

20 "(b) In civil cases, the fees of constables shall be
 21 the same as the sheriff's fees on December 18, 1973, when
 22 performing the same or like services, where the amount in

1 controversy is ~~\$20.00~~ twenty dollars (\$20) or more, except in
2 Jefferson County where constables shall receive an
3 administrative fee of ten dollars (\$10) for each process or
4 alias process issued to the constable and a fee of ~~eight~~
5 dollars ~~(\$8.00)~~ ten dollars (\$10) for actual service of each
6 process, and a gasoline allowance of ~~seven dollars (\$7.00)~~ ten
7 dollars (\$10) for the actual service of each process."

8 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
9 first day of the third month following its passage and
10 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
