"(b) In civil cases, the fees of constables shall be 12 13 the same as the sheriff's fees on December 18, 1973, when 14 performing the same or like services, where the amount in 15 controversy is \$20.00 twenty dollars (\$20) or more, except in 16 Jefferson County where constables shall receive an administrative fee of ten dollars (\$10) for each process or 17 18 alias process issued to the constable and a fee of eight 19 dollars (\$8.00) ten dollars (\$10) for actual service of each 20 process, and a gasoline allowance of seven dollars (\$7.00) ten 21 dollars (\$10) for the actual service of each process."

22 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 23 first day of the third month following its passage and 24 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
