13 Relating to the City of Wetumpka; to provide that
14 the City Council of the City of Wetumpka may authorize
15 alcoholic beverages to be sold or dispensed for on-premises
16 consumption on Sunday by restaurants, hotels, and night clubs
17 that are properly licensed retail licensees serving the
18 general public within the city.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. This act shall apply only to the City of
21 Wetumpka.

22 Section 2. The City Council of the City of Wetumpka
23 may authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises
24 consumption by restaurants, hotels, and night clubs which are
25 retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board,
26 within the municipality on Sunday between 12:00 p.m. (noon)
27 and 9:30 p.m., and on those Sundays on which New Year's Eve

1 (December 31) occurs at any time after 12:00 p.m. (noon).
2 Except as authorized by law or during those hours, it shall be
3 unlawful for any licensed vendor to sell, dispense, or permit
4 the consumption of alcoholic beverages on Sunday. The City of
5 Wetumpka may enact, by ordinance, such policies it deems
6 appropriate to regulate any aspect of Sunday alcoholic
7 beverages sales.

8 Section 3. The provisions of this act are cumulative
9 and supplemental to the present power and authority of the
10 City of Wetumpka and is not intended to, nor shall it be
11 interpreted to, repeal any existing power of authority of the
12 City of Wetumpka now permitted under the general laws of the
13 state, or under any local or special act of the Legislature.

14 Section 4. This act shall become effective
15 immediately following its passage and approval by the
16 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
