9 (10) Two members to be appointed by the President of10 the Alabama Association for Justice.

(11) The Chair of the Business Torts and Antitrust
 Law Section of the Alabama State Bar, or his or her designee.

13 (12) The President of the Alabama Circuit Judges
14 Association or a sitting or retired circuit judge appointed by
15 him or her.

(3) Report its findings and recommendations to the 9 10 Legislature at least one month prior to the convening of the 11 2016 Regular Session. 12 The committee shall be dissolved after the final 13 report is made unless otherwise authorized to continue.
