12	WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that we
13	recognize Officer Josh Heflin of the Decatur Police Department
14	as a nominee for the 2015 Alabama Legislative Medal of Honor

17	WHEREAS, while waiting on an officer he was
18	assisting on a call to return to the scene of a traffic
19	incident on March 19, 2014, around 8:58 p.m., Officer Heflin
20	was approached by a female, identified as Karmen Hill, who
21	stated her house was on fire and requested a fire
22	extinguisher; Officer Heflin gazed towards Hill's house
23	located at 819 19th Avenue and noticed heaving smoke and
24	flames billowing from the backside of the residence; and
25	WHEREAS, Officer Heflin immediately radioed dispatch
26	and called for the fire department; he learned from Hill that

her brother, Keith Harris, was still inside the residence and

had last been seen in the area of the kitchen, where the fire had originated; Officer Heflin then went to the residence and attempted to locate Harris; and

WHEREAS, without a moment's thought, Officer Heflin entered the burning residence and located Harris through heavy, dense smoke in the area of the kitchen; Officer Heflin grabbed Harris, who appeared to be confused and was suffering from smoke inhalation, by the waist and placed Harris' arms over Officer Heflin's shoulders, before leading Harris safely out of the house; and

WHEREAS, Decatur Fire and Rescue treated Harris on the scene for smoke inhalation and battled the blaze; the residence sustained severe damage from the fire; and

WHEREAS, Officer Heflin demonstrated quick thinking, diligence, and courageous determination and went over and beyond expectation to preserve a life; and

WHEREAS, Officer Heflin epitomizes the qualities of those who serve and protect, and he is truly deserving of this distinguished nomination for the Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement; now therefore,
