7 the Wallace State Community College Volleyball Team is  
8 congratulated on winning its sixth consecutive Alabama  
9 Community College Conference Championship in 2014; and

10 WHEREAS, the team finished the season with a 35-10  
11 record, including a perfect 14-0 conference record; Wallace  
12 State advanced to its sixth consecutive National Junior  
13 College Athletic Association Division I National Tournament  
14 and ACCC-record 15th national tournament appearance; and

15 WHEREAS, Coach Randy Daniel was named the 2014 ACCC  
16 Coach of the Year and he has compiled an astounding 293-68  
17 record in eight successful seasons with the Lady Lions; and

18 WHEREAS, sophomore middle hitter Syretha Pride made  
19 school history by becoming the first volleyball player to earn  
20 recognition as a NJCAA Division I First-Team All-American; she  
21 was also named the 2014 ACCC Player of the Year after  
22 finishing the season with 524 kills, 189 blocks, 78 digs, and  
23 a .556 hitting percentage; and

24 WHEREAS, sophomore outside hitter BreAnna Thompson  
25 earned an NJCAA All-American honorable mention after finishing

1 second in the conference with 423 kills, 67 blocks, and .422  
2 hitting percentage; she was the 2014 ACCC Tournament Most  
3 Valuable Player; and

4 WHEREAS, sophomore Montana Clark was named  
5 First-Team All-Region 22 and Bethany Johnson was named  
6 Second-Team All-Region 22; and

7 WHEREAS, Syretha Pride, Alexandra Gamble, and  
8 Savanna Tidwell were each named to the Alabama Community  
9 College Conference All-Tournament team; and

10 WHEREAS, the Wallace State Volleyball Team is  
11 routinely named among the NJCAA's All-Academic Teams and the  
12 players recognized for academic excellence; now therefore,

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
14 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in recognition of outstanding  
15 achievement, the Wallace State Volleyball Team is most highly  
16 commended and congratulated, and it is directed that a copy of
