11 WHEREAS, it is with great pride and pleasure that  
12 the Wallace State Community College Volleyball Team is  
13 congratulated on winning its sixth consecutive Alabama  
14 Community College Conference Championship in 2014; and

15 WHEREAS, the team finished the season with a 35-10  
16 record, including a perfect 14-0 conference record; Wallace  
17 State advanced to its sixth consecutive National Junior  
18 College Athletic Association Division I National Tournament  
19 and ACCC-record 15th national tournament appearance; and

20 WHEREAS, Coach Randy Daniel was named the 2014 ACCC  
21 Coach of the Year and he has compiled an astounding 293-68  
22 record in eight successful seasons with the Lady Lions; and

23 WHEREAS, sophomore middle hitter Syretha Pride made  
24 school history by becoming the first volleyball player to earn  
25 recognition as a NJCAA Division I First-Team All-American; she  
26 was also named the 2014 ACCC Player of the Year after

1 finishing the season with 524 kills, 189 blocks, 78 digs, and  
2 a .556 hitting percentage; and

3 WHEREAS, sophomore outside hitter BreAnna Thompson  
4 earned an NJCAA All-American honorable mention after finishing  
5 second in the conference with 423 kills, 67 blocks, and .422  
6 hitting percentage; she was the 2014 ACCC Tournament Most  
7 Valuable Player; and

8 WHEREAS, sophomore Montana Clark was named  
9 First-Team All-Region 22 and Bethany Johnson was named  
10 Second-Team All-Region 22; and

11 WHEREAS, Syretha Pride, Alexandra Gamble, and  
12 Savanna Tidwell were each named to the Alabama Community  
13 College Conference All-Tournament team; and

14 WHEREAS, the Wallace State Volleyball Team is  
15 routinely named among the NJCAA's All-Academic Teams and the  
16 players recognized for academic excellence; now therefore,
