11 Jr., a native of Huntsville, on April 11, 2015, with deep

18 Alabama and went on to work at Henderson National Bank, which
19 became First National Bank and then AmSouth; over the course
20 of his distinguished career, he served as President and CEO of
21 Monroe Business Equipment, as the Finance Director and
22 Executive Director of Business of the Huntsville City School
23 System, and as Director of Finance and Administration of the
24 Huntsville Madison County Airport Authority; and

25 WHEREAS, Mr. Kelly served as an Elder at Mayfair
26 Church of Christ; his affiliations included the Huntsville
27 Rotary Club, where he was a Paul Harris Fellow; The Chamber of

1 Commerce; the ARC of Madison County, which he served as
2 President; and the Better Business Bureau, which he served as
3 President; and

4 WHEREAS, he received the 1982 Huntsville Jaycees'
5 Outstanding Young Business Leader Award and the 1991 Chamber
6 Small Business Executive of the Year; and

7 WHEREAS, survivors include his beloved and devoted
8 wife of 44 years, Susan Franks Kelly; son, Brian Kelly
9 (April); daughter, Alicia Kelly Stryker (Joseph);
10 grandchildren, Wyatt, Vivian, and Nolan Stryker; uncle, Jack
11 Kelly; and numerous cousins; and
