8	RECOGNIZING EFFORTS TO RAISE AWARENESS OF
9	VELOCARDIOFACIAL SYNDROME.

11	WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that we
12	recognize the invaluable efforts to raise awareness of
13	Velocardiofacial Syndrome (VCFS); and
14	WHEREAS, VCFS is a genetic condition caused by the
15	deletion of a small piece of chromosome 22 that causes many
16	physical changes to the body, such as the formation of
17	distinct facial features, and can lead to heart, bone, and
18	immune system disorders, among other complications; and
19	WHEREAS, also known as 22q11.2 deletion syndrome and
20	DiGeorge Syndrome, VCFS may include such symptoms as cleft
21	palate, heart complications, learning difficulties, poor
22	eyesight, middle-ear infections, seizures resulting from low
23	levels of parathyroid hormone (PTH), low resistance to
24	infection, weak muscles, scoliosis, and low calcium levels;
25	and
26	WHEREAS, VCFS is inherited in approximately 10 to 15
27	percent of cases, but is the result of a spontaneous mutation

in some 80 to 95 percent of cases; while VCFS is known to affect approximately one in 4,000 newborns, this estimate may be low because not every person with VCFS displays significant symptoms and may never be diagnosed; and

WHEREAS, VCFS can be diagnosed based on a physical exam and the presence of standard symptoms; a blood test called FISH (Fluorescence in situ hybridization) can be done and more detailed genetic tests are possible but rare because they require much more sophisticated laboratory techniques; and

WHEREAS, the physical problems caused by VCFS are treated by dealing with symptoms; heart defects and cleft palates are treated surgically, children with low calcium or PTH levels can take supplements, and counseling, physical therapy, and speech therapy should begin early in life to assess developmental problems and manage learning delays; and

WHEREAS, the indispensable key to progress in the battle against VCFS is awareness, and those involved in this essential undertaking are truly deserving of recognition; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That it is a privilege to commend the meritorious efforts to raise awareness about VCFS, and by copy of this resolution we extend our best wishes for success in this worthy endeavor.
