11 Relating to public records; to amend Section  
12 36-12-40, Code of Alabama 1975, to prohibit a public officer  
13 from charging a copying fee if an individual uses a personal  
14 camera or other electronic device to make a copy of a public  
15 record.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. Section 36-12-40, Code of Alabama 1975,  
18 is amended to read as follows:

19 "§36-12-40.

20 "(a) Every citizen has a right to inspect and take a  
21 copy of any public ~~writing~~ record of this state, except as  
22 otherwise expressly provided by statute. Provided however,  
23 registration and circulation records and information  
24 concerning the use of the public, public school or college and  
25 university libraries of this state shall be exempted from this  
26 section. Provided further, any parent of a minor child shall  
27 have the right to inspect the registration and circulation

1 records of any school or public library that pertain to his or  
2 her child. Notwithstanding the foregoing, records concerning  
3 security plans, procedures, assessments, measures, or systems,  
4 and any other records relating to, or having an impact upon,  
5 the security or safety of persons, structures, facilities, or  
6 other infrastructures, including without limitation  
7 information concerning critical infrastructure (as defined at  
8 42 U.S.C. §5195c(e) as amended) and critical energy  
9 infrastructure information (as defined at 18 C.F.R.  
10 §388.113(c) (1) as amended) the public disclosure of which  
11 could reasonably be expected to be detrimental to the public  
12 safety or welfare, and records the disclosure of which would  
13 otherwise be detrimental to the best interests of the public  
14 shall be exempted from this section. Any public officer who  
15 receives a request for records that may appear to relate to  
16 critical infrastructure or critical energy infrastructure  
17 information, shall notify the owner of such infrastructure in  
18 writing of the request and provide the owner an opportunity to  
19 comment on the request and on the threats to public safety or  
20 welfare that could reasonably be expected from public  
21 disclosure on the records.

22 For the purposes of this section, "public record"  
23 does not include personal, non-public information of any  
24 Alabama citizen.

25 "(b) A fee may not be charged if an individual uses  
26 a personal camera or other electronic device to make a copy of  
27 a public record; provided, however, a reasonable service fee

1 may be charged if a copy must be made in order for the  
2 custodian of the record to redact a document or information  
3 from a document to protect from disclosure personal,  
4 non-public information; provided, however, a copying fee may  
5 be charged if a paper copy must be made in order to redact  
6 identifying information, as defined in Section 41-13-7, prior  
7 to making the record public. A public official may not refuse  
8 the use of a personal camera or other electronic device for  
9 making copies of a public record unless the camera or other  
10 electronic device unduly interferes with the operation of the  
11 public office. This subdivision shall not apply to any record  
12 converted to digital or electronic format and available to the  
13 public by digital or electronic means."

14 (c) Nothing in this act shall apply to the probate  
15 courts in Alabama.

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
17 first day of the third month following its passage and  
18 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
