## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the 8 9 budget proposed each year for the Alabama Department of 10 Environmental Management shall include as a line item in the 11 General Fund Budget the Navigable Waters Dredging Fund for the 12 dredging of the navigable waters of this state and for sediment reuse. The director of the department shall present 13 14 the proposed budget at the appropriate budget hearing 15 scheduled by the Alabama Legislature.

Section 2. (a) There is established a Navigable Waters Dredging Fund which shall be administered by the Alabama Department of Environmental Management which funds shall be paid to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for the purposes of dredging the navigable waters of this state and for sediment reuse. The principal of the fund shall consist of the following:
