9		has statutory authority to levy or assess fees that
10		are retained by the agency to fund operations or
11		programs under its control to increase the fee.
12		This bill would provide that the increase would be
13		based on the percentage increase in the Consumer
14		Price Index for all urban consumers as published by
15		the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor

To allow a state agency that is authorized to levy or assess fees that are retained by the agency to fund its operations or programs to increase the fees by the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics during a specified period.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Any state agency that statutorily levies or assesses fees retained by the agency to fund its operations or programs may increase the fee by the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics from the end of December in the tenth year preceding the year in which the fee increase is to be effective or from the end of December in the last year the fee was increased, whichever period is shorter, to the end of the month preceding the month in which the fee increase is to be effective, rounded down to the nearest dollar. Thereafter, every five years the agency may repeat this process using the Consumer Price Index for the previous five years forward to the date of the requested change. The change may not exceed an increase of two percent per year.

(b) Any change in a fee schedule pursuant to this act is a rule for purposes of the Alabama Administrative

Procedure Act.

1	(c) If an increase is adopted, the assessed increase
2	of the fee shall be retained by the agency to fund its
3	operations or programs under the control of the agency.
4	Section 2. This act shall become effective
5	immediately following its passage and approval by the
6	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
