16	To amend Sections 17-13-3 and 17-13-100, Code of

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. Sections 17-13-3 and 17-13-100, Code of
22	Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:
23	<b>"</b> §17-13-3.
24	"(a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b),
25	primary elections, except special primary elections and
26	presidential preference primaries, held at the expense of the
27	state or counties, shall be held on the first Tuesday in June

When necessary, as provided in this chapter, a second or runoff primary election shall be held on the sixth Tuesday following the primary election. Any second primary shall be held by the same election officers who held the first primary, and be held at the same places as the first primary election.

No primary shall be held by any political party except as herein provided. Primary elections herein provided for shall be held at the regular polling places established for the purpose of holding general elections.

- "(b) In years in which a presidential primary is conducted, the primary election shall be the  $\frac{1}{2}$  tuesday in March.
- "(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in any year in which the primary election is held in March and the primary election is held in conjunction with the presidential preference primary election, as provided in this section and Section 17-13-100, any reference in any existing statutes to a primary election being held in June shall be construed to refer to the primary election in March.

"\$17-13-100.

- "(a) Primary elections for the purpose of determining the preferred candidates for President of the United States shall be held the second <u>first</u> Tuesday in March each year in which a President is to be elected beginning in the year 2012 2016.
- "(b) Subject to rules and procedures of the political party of any presidential candidate, the names of

any candidates for delegate to the national conventions 1 2 pledged to a presidential candidate shall be placed under his or her name and the delegates shall be elected in the primary 3 election as provided herein. "(c) The State of Alabama shall reimburse a county 5 for all sums expended in holding and conducting the 6 7 presidential preference primary as provided in Section 17-16-4." 8 9 Section 2. This act shall become effective 10 immediately following its passage and approval by the

Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
