26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The provisions of Act 2014-429 as they apply to employers participating in the Employees' Retirement System pursuant to Sections 36-27-6, 36-27-7, and 36-27-7.1 shall be extended if a participating employer elects to come under the provisions of Act 2014-429 by official resolution on or before September 30, 2015. Upon such election by official resolution on or before September 30, 2015, the lump-sum payments provided under Act 2014-429 shall be paid to all eligible recipients who are entitled to receive a lump-sum payment under Act 2014-429 and are receiving a benefit as of September 30, 2015 by the Employees' Retirement System in December 2015. Any employer making such election shall bear the cost of the lump-sum payment paid to its retirees, as provided in Act 2014-429.

Section 2. This act shall become effective

immediately following its passage and approval by the

Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
