6 ENROLLED, An Act,

7 Relating to the City of Millbrook in Elmore and  
8 Autauga Counties; to authorize the city council to regulate  
9 and permit the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sundays under  
10 certain conditions by retail licensees of the Alcoholic  
11 Beverage Control Board; and to authorize the city council to  
12 provide for the sale of draft beer, with certain exceptions,  
13 by retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

15 Section 1. This act shall apply only within the  
16 corporate limits of the City of Millbrook in Elmore and  
17 Autauga Counties.

18 Section 2. The City Council of the City of  
19 Millbrook, by resolution, may regulate and permit the sale for  
20 on premises consumption only of alcoholic beverages on Sunday  
21 after 12:00 p.m. upon the licensed premises of retail  
22 licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board of the State  
23 of Alabama and of the City of Millbrook serving the general  
24 public including, but not limited to, hotels and conference  
25 centers and golf courses located within the corporate limits

1 of the city. Any licensee granted authority to sell alcoholic  
2 beverages on Sunday pursuant to this act shall be required to  
3 have all servers of alcoholic beverages complete responsible  
4 vendor training in the manner provided by the Alcoholic  
5 Beverage Control Board.

6 Section 3. The City Council of the City of  
7 Millbrook, by resolution, may authorize the sale and  
8 distribution of draft beer by retail licensees of the  
9 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. Notwithstanding the  
10 foregoing, keg beer may not be sold for off-premises  
11 consumption.

12 Section 4. This act is cumulative and supplemental  
13 to the present power and authority of the City of Millbrook,  
14 and is not intended to, nor shall it be interpreted, to repeal  
15 any existing power or authority of the city now permitted  
16 under the general laws of the state or under any local or  
17 special act of the Legislature.

18 Section 5. This act shall become effective  
19 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
20 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
