8 COMMENDING REVEREND DALLAS DAY, JR., ON HIS
9 SUCCESSFUL PASTORAL CAREER.

11 WHEREAS, a native of Orville, Alabama, Dallas Day,
12 Jr., was born on September 25, 1935, to the late Dallas Day,
13 Sr., and Joanna Ellis Day; and

14 WHEREAS, the eldest of 13 children, Reverend Day
15 received his primary and secondary education in Raymond public
16 schools before his 37-year employment with United States Pipe
17 and Foundry in Bessemer, Alabama; and

18 WHEREAS, ordained into the gospel ministry in 1977,
19 Dallas Day, Jr., served as an associate pastor of First
20 Baptist Church Carver until 1978, when he was called and
21 served as pastor for 17 years, during which time many
22 improvements were made to the growing church and numerous
23 souls were saved; and

24 WHEREAS, desiring to further his studies, Reverend
25 Day earned an Associate of Arts Degree from Faith College and

1 later was a founding member of the First Baptist Carver Place,
2 appropriately named after the community which it served; and

3 WHEREAS, retiring from his pastorate in 1995,
4 Reverend Dallas Day, Jr., continues to minister to his
5 congregation as pastor emeritus under the leadership of Bishop
6 Sherman L. Young; now therefore,

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
8 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we hereby recognize the many
9 years of devoted service of Reverend Dallas Day, Jr., to his
10 God, his church, and his community, and provide a copy of this
