3 (c) This section shall apply at the expiration of 4 the term of office of the current county superintendent of 5 education or upon any vacancy occurring in the office of the 6 county superintendent of education before the expiration of 7 his or her current term of office.

8 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict 9 with this act are repealed, and Act 163, 1923 Regular Session 10 (Local Acts 1923, p. 79) and Act 524, 1959 Regular Session 11 (Acts 1959, p. 1300), are specifically repealed.

12 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the 13 first day of the third month following its passage and 14 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
