11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Lawrence County; providing for the
14 merging of the budgetary operations of the revenue
15 commissioner's office; providing that the office shall be
16 financed on a pro rata basis from proceeds of state, county,
17 municipal, and any other ad valorem taxes collected in the
18 county; and providing for supplemental effect.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. The Revenue Commissioner of Lawrence
21 County may take the necessary action to merge the budgetary
22 operations and functions of his or her office. The expenses of
23 the office shall be financed on a pro rata share basis from
24 the proceeds of any state, county, and municipal ad valorem
25 taxes collected in the county in the same manner as the salary
26 of the revenue commissioner is paid pursuant to Section
27 40-6A-2, Code of Alabama 1975. Any funds retained pursuant to

1 this act shall be used solely for the operation of the office
2 of revenue commissioner subject to approval of the budget for
3 the office by the county commission in the same manner as the
4 budget is currently approved.

5 Section 2. The provisions of this act are
6 supplemental. It shall be construed in pari materia with other
7 laws regulating the Revenue Commissioner's Office in Lawrence
8 County; however, those laws or parts of laws which are in
9 direct conflict or inconsistent herewith are repealed. This
10 act shall not affect the payment of commissions as otherwise
11 provided by law.

12 Section 3. This act shall become effective
13 immediately following its passage and approval by the
14 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
