11 WHEREAS, we deeply regret and are greatly saddened
12 to learn of the death of Dr. Lonnie George McCormick, 79 years
13 old, of Huntsville, Alabama, and we uplift his inspiring life
14 and legacy with utmost reverence and respect; and

15 WHEREAS, the passing of Dr. Lonnie McCormick leaves
16 a void in the lives of his loving family, many friends, and
17 the entire community, where he was highly regarded; and

18 WHEREAS, Dr. McCormick was born to the union of Carl
19 and Valanta McCormick in 1937 in Kirbytown, Alabama, and grew
20 up in Manchester, Tennessee; he attended Tennessee Tech
21 University and graduated from the University of Tennessee
22 College of Medicine in 1961; and

23 WHEREAS, Dr. McCormick interned at the University of
24 Tennessee and completed a Radiology residency at Baptist
25 Hospital in Memphis; he served as a Captain in the United
26 States Army Medical Corps from 1966 until 1968; and

1 WHEREAS, Dr. McCormick practiced radiology in
2 Huntsville, Alabama, from 1968 until 2013; he contributed
3 exceptional direction as President of the Madison County
4 Medical Society and as President of the Huntsville Academy of
5 Medicine; and

6 WHEREAS, he was a faithful and devoted member of
7 First Presbyterian Church, where he served as a deacon; his
8 interests included art and horticulture and he was a member of
9 the Huntsville Museum of Art Foundation; and

10 WHEREAS, Dr. McCormick was a loving husband and
11 father known for his wit, wisdom, compassion, and generosity;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, survivors include his beloved and devoted
14 wife of 32 years, Susie; daughters, Kellye McCormick and Anna
15 Hornsby (John); sons, Grant McCormick (Beth) and Patrick
16 McCormick; granddaughters, Savannah McCormick and Laura Fallon
17 (Ben); step-grandson, Dawson Crow; great-granddaughter, Lyla
18 Fallon; and a large extended family; and

19 WHEREAS, Dr. Lonnie McCormick was a valued member of
20 the community; although his presence is greatly missed, his
21 memory is cherished in the hearts and minds of all those who
22 were fortunate enough to know him; now therefore,
