3 WHEREAS, Dr. Brown was a Commissioned Officer in the
4 United States Army Reserve, Adjutant General Corps from 1973
5 until 1981; during his career, Dr. Brown has published
6 numerous works, participated in numerous conferences, and been
7 a guest speaker on many occasions; and

8 WHEREAS, Dr. Brown served as President of the Athens
9 State Faculty Senate 1994-1995 and has served as Chair for
10 numerous committees at Athens State College including:
11 Academic Affairs Committee of the Faculty; VISION 2020
12 Committee; Library Committee, SACS Reaccreditation Process for
13 Athens State; Department of Government and Public Affairs;
14 Search Committee for Dean of Arts and Science; Committee to
15 Evaluate Faculty Credentials, Reaccreditation of Athens State
16 University; Committee for Revision of By-laws Related to
17 Faculty Governance, and Campus Facilities Committee;
18 additionally, he has served in numerous other capacities and
19 on many other committees; and

20 WHEREAS, throughout his career Dr. Brown has served
21 with honor, integrity, and an unwavering commitment to
22 excellence; his dedication, ability, experience, and service
23 will be greatly missed; he has earned immense respect for his
24 tireless dedication and exceptional abilities and his record
